 - 1. Roll Call: Resolution Finally Approving and Confirming Plans, Specifications and Form of Contract for 18th Street Trail Project (IDOT letting 1-17-2018);

Bids will be received by the Iowa DOT on January 17, 2018 for the 18th Street Trail Project. This project is construction of a trail running parallel to West 18th Street from 4th Avenue West to 18th Avenue West. The cost is estimated to be \$499,480.00

5. **New Business:**

A. Roll Call: Ordinance Amending Title 4, Chapter 4, Section 3(A)(4) of the Spencer City Code Concerning Requirements for Connections to New Public Sewer Mains, 1st Filing;

The amendment to this ordinance allows property owner's a 5 year extension of connection to public sewer mains after construction of the main. In addition, the property owner may obtain an inspection of the private sewage disposal system. Upon a successful completion of the inspection, an additional 5 year extension may be granted as long as the private treatment system continues to function.
