Kathy Fueston, Co. Chair for the Clay County Trail Association: "I guess my reason for being here tonight, we've heard a lot of things about this Rail Trail. We've heard comments about what will and won't happen. We heard that if the Graham property did sell that it would be contingent upon the fact that all the other property owners north of that area would also have to buy the property so we wouldn't have a section of an abandoned rail right in the middle of the trail system and have all this other property that the City owned because it wasn't a whole lot of worth to them. So I guess I am here in opposition of it: A because I do believe the rail is the best route for the trail, I do understand that you have again changed the way the trail would be routed if you go ahead with the sale of property. So again there's questions it seems like there's a lot of unanswered questions as far. Where will that trail actually go, will it actually happen, what will happen to the land north of Grahams that the City does own and can't do a whole lot with. And I guess as a citizen of Spencer, Iowa I believe that we all do deserve answers on that, and I'm not exactly sure how that happens, but I've read things in the paper but none of those issues have been addressed so I think for the people who have a passion for biking and trail systems, I think it's a huge disservice. A: to sell that property and I've always felt that way. And at the same time I think it's not right that we don't know exactly what's gonna happen or how that trail is going to be orchestrated. We do know one thing; it will be more expensive to send it down 4th Avenue West than it would be to use the existing rail line. So my opposition just seeks answers on what the Council's true mission is to complete that trail system to the North side of Spencer. I feel like we need to know what your doing with the unused property North that you actually probably can't do a whole lot with. It's probably basically unusable to the City.
