



# PLASTIC RECYCLING GUIDE



Recyclable plastics are usually in the form of containers that have been used for human consumption and bought from your supermarket.

• Plastic # 6, commonly referred to Styrofoam.... is NOT RECYCLABLE... best to AVOID using.... purchase with a purpose....

## Recycle these plastics in your curbside bin:

- Plastic Soda, Water, and Other Drink Bottles
- Plastic Food and Household Bottles & Jars
  - Plastic Tubs & Lids
- Plastic Produce, Deli & Bakery Containers, Cups, Trays
  - Plastic Non-food Containers & Packaging
- Plastic bags can be bagged within one bag & put in the bin.
- Rinse & clean food and other residue.... put caps back on Bottles & Jars.

## Plastic by the numbers:

- Plastic #'s 1,2,4,5 are your most commonly found plastics and are VERY RECYCLABLE in your curbside bin.
- Plastic #'s 3 & 7 are not commonly found in everyday consumer usage.... may require some investigation in regards to recycling.
