### Glass Drop off



#### ACCEPTED

- Glass Food and Beverage Containers
- All Colors. No Sorting Required
- Labels and Caps Can Remain on the Glasses
- Glassware, Such as Wine or Pint Glasses

#### NOT ACCEPTED

- No Windshields
- No Ceramic, Porcelain, or Milk Glass
- No Laminated Glass or Lead Crystal Glass
- No Mirrors, Pyrex, Corningware or Dishware

**Make Sure Your Glass Containers are Clean, Empty, and Do Not Put Them in Recycle Containers With Bags & Boxes.**

### Other Recyclables Drop Off



#### ACCEPTED

- Newspaper and Newspaper Inserts Made of Paper
- Magazines, Phone Books and Catalogs
- Paper Junk Mail and Envelopes
- Flattened Cardboard
- Office and School Paper (Colored Paper too!)
- Boxboard/Paperboard e.g. Cereal Boxes
- Aluminum Cans
- Tin and Steel Cans
- Plastic Bags and Plastic Film (Multiple Bags Within One Bag)
- Plastic Containers, Bottles, Detergent Bottles, Milk Jugs and Caps (Anything With a Neck)

#### NOT ACCEPTED

- Food, Yard, or Pet Waste
- Diapers, Toilet Paper, Paper Towels, or Facial Tissue
- Batteries, Wiring, or Electronics
- Household Hazardous Waste & Medical Waste
- New or Used Clothing
- Styrofoam e.g. Plates, Cups, or Egg Cartons
- Ceramics and Light Bulbs
- Glass or Lumber
- Dinnerware or Glassware
- Big Durable Plastics Like Lawn Furniture & Kids Toys
- Explosive or Hazardous Materials Like Ammunition
- Liquids in Containers
